
TONES OF GREY PROVIDE A STRIKING AND POPULAR BASE, HIGHLIGHTED WITH A FLASH OF BLUE.







PROPORTIONS

TONES OF MOSS GREEN, MUSTARD YELLOW AND ROSE CREATE A VIBRANT AND PLAYFUL FEEL WITHIN THIS PALETTE. THESE BESPOKE COLOURS ARE GROUNDED WITH THE MORE CALMING SHADES OF LAVENDER AND BEIGE, SO AS NOT TO OVERPOWER THE HOME.



LAVENDER IS SUBTLE ENOUGH TO BE USED OVER LARGE AREAS, CREATING A WARM AND CALMING BASE. ROSE AND DUSKY BLUE TONES WORK IN HARMONY WITH THIS PALETTE AND CAN BE USED TO CREATE FOCAL POINTS.



FOR A MORE VIBRANT EFFECT, USE ROSE WITH INJECTIONS OF MOSS GREEN AND MUSTARD YELLOW.

COMPLIMENTARY FINISHES

THIS COLOUR SCHEME WORKS WELL WITH NEUTRAL SHADES OF SATIN STONE GREY AND CONTRASTING WOOD TEXTURES. ALTERNATIVELY, USE OUR NORDIC TEAL OR LIGHT GREY DOORS AS A BASE FOR YOUR WARDROBE, AND BRING TO LIFE WITH A SPLASH OF HEATHER OR ROSE.
